## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, in many communities of the world today, the individual's rights to freedom of religious worship, of speech, and of peaceable assemblage are denied; and

WHEREAS, these rights are a fundamental part of the American ideal of independence declared on July 4, 1776;

THEREFORE, I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of Minnesota, urge all our citizens on this coming Independence Day to set aside a portion of that day as an occasion on which to rededicate themselves and their children to the practice and preservation of these American ideals of freedom of speech, assembly, and religious worship.
