ORDER PROVIDING ADDITIONAL PROPERTY OF CHARACT DEGRAPMY GATE TIMES

To the people of the State of Minnesota, to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, to the Law Inforcement Officers of the Conservation Department of the State of Minnesota; and to all others whom it may concern: GREWINGS:

WHERMAS, by federal regulation, vails and gailfunles, except coot, may be taken in this state, prior to October 1, 1955, the opening date for the taking of ducks, goese, jacksnipe and coot, under federal regulation, and

of ducks, george ships and coot while hunting such rails and gallimles prior to Ockober 2; and

such ducks, resembling and coot and cause them to leave their usual places of habitato and

investigated the necessity of providing additional protection to ducks, goese, snipe and coot, and has recommended such additional protection,

WOW, THENEFORE, I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, in order to provide additional protection to ducks, geese, snipe and coot and to prevent their taking, disturbing, harrying and worrying and consequent depletion thereof, prior to October I, 1938, pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 5640, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, do hereby order, that rails and gallinules, for which an open season has been declared, may be taken, commencing October 1, 1938 and continuing to Movember 14, 1938, both dates inclusive, daily shooting hours to be from 7:00 o'clock A.M. to 4:00 o'clock, P.M.
