

BBOCLAMATION

I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of Minnesota, hereby designate the week of

OCTOBER FIRST TO OCTOBER NINTH INCLUSIVE

as

NATIONAL AIR TRAVEL WEEK

to be observed in this State to commemorate the first ten years of successful passenger transportation by air.

As the end of the first decade in this type of transportation and interstate commerce comes to a close, it behooves every citizen, every State organization and every patriotic American to observe this week as a tribute to the heroic work, great advancement, and increased public convenience which all phases of the aviation industry have so nobly accomplished.

We, as American citizens, can feel proud of these developments which have put America in a leading position in world aviation. We can be proud of our National Government in bringing to fulfillment recent legislation which has created a new Civil Aeronautics Authority, in principle pledged to "Foster and encourage civil aeronautics in this country and abroad." În this body, our Government has given our aviation industry a bulwark of strength upon which it can build during the next decade, and through which it can make even greater advancements than those we are honoring during National Air Travel Week.

We have been fortunate in that those men in our aviation industry are men of vision, courage, resourcefulness and action. Such men have given this country better equipment, more convenient schedules, a choice of dependable airlines criss-crossing the country, and have brought about economies which give our travelers today the opportunity to take advantage of these improvements. Our men in aviation today have accelerated business and pleasure travel which brings to all parts of



the nation, including our own State, accelerated progress.

Let us therefore observe this week as one of tribute to our aviation industry, and as the beginning of another era which will bring ever greater advancements and prestige to our State and our country.

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Minnesota has resolved that October 11th of each year shall be observed as "General Pulaski's Memorial Day", and

WHEREAS, October 11, 1938 marks the One Hundred and Fiftyninth anniversary of the death of General Casimir Pulaski, Revolutionary War hero, and

WHEREAS, It is most fitting that recognition should be given to the memory of this illustrious son of Poland, who rendered such valuable assistance to the cause of American freedom, and who died on October 11, 1779 of wounds received in that struggle,

THEREFORE, I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby designate

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 11, 1938

as

PULASKI MEMORIAL DAY

and urge its observance by the people of this State, with such ceremonies as may be deemed appropriate; and I also request public
officials and people generally to display the flag of the United States
on that day.
