TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN AND FOR MORRISON COUNTY,
MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned electors and residents upon the lands hereinafter described, to-wit: All the unplatted part of the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 28; $E\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20; $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21; all that part of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29 lying South of the Minneapolis and St. Paul railroad tracks; and all of Blocks 1 to 11 inclusive of the Plat of Hillman, formerly being a part of the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 28, all of the hereinbefore described real estate being located in Township 41, Range 28, of Morrison County, Minnesota; respectfully request the Board of County Commissioners to appoint a time and place, when and where the electors actually residing upon said real estate may vote for or against the incorporation of all of said territory into a village to be known as the Village of Hillman, in the County of Morrison, State of Minnesota.
