

An Ordinance changing the name of the Village of Bronson to that of the village of Lake Bronson.

The Village Council of the Village of Brandon do  
ordain as follows:

1. That the Village of Bronson, Kittson County, Minnesota, shall hereafter be known as the village of Lake Bronson, Kittson County, Minnesota.
  2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.

Dated this 1st day of November, 1900, and signed officially by the President and Clerk of the village after being passed by the required four-fifths vote of all members of the village council.
