I, P. S. Engman, first being duly sworn, depose and say: Prior to Oct. 26, 1938, this deponent was duly appointed by the secretary of state of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 417, Laws of 1921 as supervisor of census, and Eino Halunen, Eli Bodovinitz, John Remus, Aune Heikkinen, Dorsey Gray, Edward Farconi, Peter Jedda, Jr., John Ellison, August Ketola, Charles Carlson, Marcel Kishel, John Berttula, Harry W. Gillespie, Esther Krog, Dorothy Davidson, Charles Nelson, Clarence Wilson, and Genevieve Steranko all of the City of Virginia and State of Minnesota, were duly appointed by said secretary of state, pursuant to said act, as enumerators of the census, and this deponent and the eighteen above mentioned enumerators were directed by the Secretary of Sate aforesaid to take a census of the residents of City of 8418 Virginia, St. Louis County, Minnesota.

That, thereafter, this deponent and said enumerators agreed in writing and under oath to perform their duties in connection



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with said census faithfully and importially and under the direction of said Secretary of State, as more fully appears from Exhibits A and E, hereto attached and made a part hereof.

That between the dates of Oct. 36 and Nov. 8,1938, all of the inhabitants of said City were personally interviewed by one of the eighteen enumerators above mentioned, working under deponent's supervision; that a separate card was prepared for each of the residents of said district, contailing the name of such resident, and also containing other data, required by the Secretary of State; that these cards wereprepared by said enumerators under the direction of this deponent and said cards have been duly filed with said Secretary of State; that the facts stated on said cards are true and reference is hereby made thereto for that purpose.

That, as a result of said census, it appears that there were on Mov 8, 1938, <u>Twelve-thousand</u>, three hundred and nineteen REGIDENTS (12,319A) of said City of Virginia.

That, after the enumeration of the inhabitants of said City of Virginia each of the eighteen above mentioned enumerators and this deponent executed an affidavit to the effect that the facts stated in said cards were true. Said affidavits were hereto attached and made a part hereof and marked Exhibits A and E.

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
