WHEREAS, it is intended to give Minnesotans a better understanding of themselves, and non-residents an understanding of our state and its people, and


WHEREAS, the publication of this book is an expression of the growing recognition that culture is a concern of government as well as of the private citizen;

NOVEMBER 28 - DECEMBER 3, 1938


