FOR CONGRESSMEN



I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby certify that as shown by the official returns made by the State Canvassing Board on November 22, 1938, duly certified to me by the Secretary of State, of the votes cast at the General Election held on November 8, 1938, for Representatives in Congress from the State of Minnesota: First District, AUGUST H. ANDRESEN, Second District, ELMER J. RYAN, Third District, JOHN G. ALEXANDER, Fourth District, MELVIN J. MAAS, Fifth District, OSCAR YOUNGDAHL, Sixth District, HAROLD KNUTSON, Seventh District, H. CARL ANDERSEN, Eighth District, WILLIAM A. PITTENGER, and Ninth District, RICHARD THOMPSON BUCKLER, were declared to have received the highest number of votes cast for the office of Representatives in Congress from the State of Minnesota and declared duly elected to that office.
