

An open-backed, one-lid, shallow box 21 x 75 x 10 mm.
Can be so inflated so as to rise above the surface of water
completely. It has a long tube which is closed at the
bottom and has two holes near the top, one on each side.
Closes in 20 sec. in the water, or can be closed by hand
longer. When inflated holds air 100 sec. and can be inflated
again 100 sec. after being opened. Air is admitted through
a 11 mm. hole in the front. There are 110 g. zinc plates which can
