

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114 of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint Albert Steinhauser, of New Elm, Minnesota, Special Attorney for the commissioner of highways as a Title Attorney in the right of Way Department, to serve as such special attorney at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. The compensation of the said Albert Steinhauser is hereby fixed in the sum of \$2700.00 per annum, which shall be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Fund. Said appointment shall take effect on the first day of February, 1939.


