RESOLUTION # 49

Iron is of the opinion that there has been an increase in the population of said Village since the last state and federal census, and that it is, therefore, beneficial to said Village to have a special state census taken in said Village during the year 1939,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota is hereby requested to take a special census of the population of said Village of Mt. Iron pursuant to the statutes in such case made and provided.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk send a certified copy of this resolution to the Secretary of State and that the expense of such census be paid by the Village of Mt. Iron.
