

OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

Now, I, J. A. Burquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, do hereby constitute and appoint Edward Lindquist, of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Counsel in the Department of Agriculture for the purpose of defending the Commissioner of Agriculture in any actions brought against him by employees of the department who have been discharged or removed, claiming preference under the Soldiers Preference Law, and I hereby fix his compensation at the sum of \$25.00 per day for time actually spent in the preparation and trial of said cases, said sums to be paid by the Department of Agriculture; said appointee to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.
