


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint Edward Lindquist, of Olivia, Minnesota, as Special Counsel in the Department of Agriculture for the purpose of defending the Commissioner of Agriculture in any actions brought against him and investigating the same, and I hereby fix his compensation at the sum of \$25.00 per day for time actually spent in the preparation and trial of said cases, said sums to be paid by the Department of Agriculture; said appointee to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 16th day of February, 1939.


