I CERTIFY That, satisfactory evidence having been exhibited of the appointment of *Henry Carl Johan Steinhart* — as *Vice Consul of Norway, at St. Paul, Minnesota,* — the President of the United States of America has ordered his recognition as such officer, declaring him free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers, and privileges as are allowed to *Vice Consuls by the laws of Nations, or by the laws of the United States.*
