

EXECUTIVE CERTIFICATE OF EXISTENCE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Pope County, Minnesota, has adopted and submitted to me a resolution declaring that an emergency exists making it necessary to borrow the sum of \$20,000.00 (twenty thousand dollars) for the relief of the poor in said County of Pope without submitting the question of issuance of bonds or other evidence of indebtedness to the vote of the electors of said County; and

WHEREAS, after investigation, I find that said amount is within the reasonable needs of said Pope County in providing support and relief of poor persons having a legal settlement therein; and that no other funds are available to meet the same; and that it is neither possible or practicable in view of the other governmental needs of said Pope County to secure said amount from other sources or by the regular methods of borrowing.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the provisions of Chapter 120, Laws of Minnesota for 1933 as amended by Chapter 48, Laws of Minnesota for 1935 and by Chapter 105, Laws of Minnesota for 1937, I do hereby certify that an emergency exists in the County of Pope sufficient to warrant the issuance by said County of Pope of bonds in the aggregate amount of \$20,000.00 (twenty thousand dollars).
