The above entitled matter came duly on for  
hearing on March 23, 1939, before me, Harold L. Stassen,  
Governor of Minnesota, upon complaints of malfeasance  
in office made to me against Robert J. Seiberlich, mem-  
ber of the State Athletic Commission, after due notice  
to him. Robert J. Seiberlich appeared in person and by  
his attorney, Louis Solon of Minneapolis. Hayes, Morgan  
and Fisch, attorneys, of Minneapolis appeared for certain  
complainants and Donald C. Rogard, the commissioner, and  
Hayes Dansenberg, Assistant Attorney General, appeared  
at my request.

Upon the evidence taken before Donald C. Rogard,  
who was duly appointed by me as special commissioner for  
such purpose, which evidence was duly recorded and submit-  
ted to me, and upon the arguments of counsel together with  
the brief submitted by Mr. Louis Solon, I find that Robert  
J. Seiberlich is guilty of malfeasance in office in that  
he improperly used his official position as a member of  
the State Athletic Commission to further his private busi-  
ness interests.
