

Ordinance No. 1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LONG BEACH, IN THE COUNTY OF MARSHALL.

THE CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF LONG BEACH.

The village council of Long Beach do ordains:

Section 1. Village Boundaries Extended.--Pursuant to a petition duly signed by the owner of (or majority of the owners of) the land abutting upon the village of Long Beach described as follows:

6.24 acres consisting of Lot Six (6), section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Twenty-five (125), Range Thirty-eight (38) and Lot One (1) State Subdivision of the Northeast Quarter (NE_{1/4}) of Section Sixteen (16), Township One Hundred Twenty-five (125), Range Thirty-eight (38), County of Pope, State of Minnesota.

the territorial limits of this village are hereby extended to include the aforesaid territory within its said limits and the aforesaid lands shall here after be a part of the village and shall be governed as other territory of the village is governed.

Section 2. Copy to be Filed with Register of Deeds and Secretary of State.

The village clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this ordinance to the register of deeds and the Secretary of State.

Section 3. Effect.--The aforesaid territory shall be annexed to the village upon the adoption hereof.
