WHEREAS, A growing support has been given to the national observance of one Sunday in each year as Father's Day, and

WHEREAS, It appears that the sons and daughters of Minnesota, as well as the other states of the union, are in enthusiastic accord with such observance -- placing their fathers in a well deserved position of honor beside their mothers;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HAROLD E. STASSER, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 17, 1939, as Father's Day in the state of Minnesota, and urge that the citizens of Minnesota on this day make a special effort to honor our fathers.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and cause to be affixed the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota, at the Capitol in St. Paul, this thirty-first day of May, in the year of our Lord, Nineteen Hundred and Thirty-nine.
