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Petition to the County Board of the County of Anoka in the State of Minnesota to call an election for the determination of the proposed incorporation of the Village of Centerville.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka in the State of Minnesota:-

Antecedent:- The undersigned do respectfully represent and show to your Honorable Board:-

First:- That they and each of them are legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, proposed to be incorporated as the Village of Centerville.

Second:- That they have on this 21st day of August, A.D. 1910, caused to be taken an accurate census of the resident population of the territory to be incorporated, and that there are according to said census, and on said day, two hundred and ~~seventeen~~ ^{twenty seven} (227) persons actually resident upon the territory, proposed to be incorporated, and that the actual resident population of said territory and on said day is two hundred and ~~seventeen~~ ^{twenty seven} (227).

Third:- That no part of said territory proposed to be incorporated is within any incorporated village.

Fourth:- That all of said territory is within the State of Minnesota, and a portion thereof has been platted into lots and blocks, by plat duly and legally certified according to the laws of this State, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County of Anoka, wherein all of said lots and blocks are situated and lie, and the unplatted portion of said territory proposed to be incorporated adjoins the platted portion thereof, and all of said territory proposed to be incorporated is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Fifth:- That the name of the village proposed to be incorporated is the Village of Centerville.

Sixth:- That the boundaries of the territory proposed to be incorporated are as follows, to-wit:- Commencing at the quarter corner post on the east side of section fourteen (14), thence south one half mile to the southeast corner of said section fourteen; thence east one quarter mile to the one sixteenth corner post on the north side of the northwest quarter of section twenty four; thence south one mile to the one sixteenth corner post on the south side of the southwest quarter of section twenty four;

Incorporation of the Village of Centerville.**

Notice is hereby given that a petition, of which a full, true and correct copy is hereto attached, has been filed in the office of the County Auditor of the County of Anoka in the State of Minnesota, and presented to the County Board of said County, and approved by said County Board; that pursuant to said petition and in accordance with the statutes in such case made and provided, an election for the determination of such proposed incorporation will be held at Centerville Hall, in the Postoffice Building, in the Town of Centerville, in the County of Anoka and State of Minnesota, on Saturday the 22nd 24th day of September, A.D. 1910, between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and five o'clock in the afternoon of said day; that Victor Huxte, Louis A.
