


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. BURNQUIST, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, and particularly by Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 114, and upon the written request of Harry E. Speakes, Director of the Division of Game and Fish in the Department of Conservation, do hereby constitute and appoint WILLIAM MERRILL, of Glenwood, Minnesota, as SPECIAL ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL for said Division of Game and Fish, to act as attorney for the defendants Ray Neumann and G. O. Grendahl, game wardens, in an action pending in the District Court of Pope County, Sixteenth Judicial District, State of Minnesota, entitled Henry Glieden, Plaintiff, vs. said Neumann and Grendahl, Defendants. Said appointment shall commence forthwith and shall continue until the final disposition of said action, subject to termination otherwise at the pleasure of the Attorney General. The compensation for said service shall be subject to the approval of the Attorney General and shall be paid by said Division of Game and Fish.
