

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Fourth of July is set aside as a national holiday commemorative of our birth as a nation of the world, and a day to be observed in pleasant and beneficial pursuits; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of every American to assist in enabling such observance, free from the experiences of death and injuries from traffic accidents and other preventable causes,

THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, under and by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Minnesota; and in cooperation with the Minnesota Safety Council, do hereby proclaim and set aside the period of from Friday, June thirtieth, to Wednesday, July fifth, 1939, as one calling for and requiring utmost endeavor upon the part of all citizens to prevent the recurrence of the accident experience of previous holidays in our State and Nation.
