

Chesley, State Registrar of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of authority vested in me by statute and particularly by authority of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 5354, as amended by Chapter 263, Laws 1937, do hereby constitute and appoint Maxine Burke of St. Paul Park, Minnesota, Deputy State Registrar for a term commencing on the 26th day of June, 1939 and ending on the 10th day of July, 1939.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 23rd day of June, 1939.


