No. The undersigned legal voters residing within the territory hereinabove described, do hereby respectfully petition the County Board of the County of Crow Wing, Minnesota, to call an election for the purpose of determining the proposed incorporation of the Village of Melicon Lakes pursuant to the provision of Chapter 9, Nixon's Minnesota Statutes of 1887.

The territory proposed to be incorporated consists of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 18, 19, 20, 21, the north half of 10, 22 and 31, all in the Township of Pollock, County of Crow Wing, Minnesota. Said territory consists of certain property which has been platted into blocks and lots and for which plats have been duly and legally certified according to the law of Minnesota and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of said county, and are designated as follows, to-wit: "Jacott's First Subdivision of Breezy Point" and "Bigwater Beach" and it includes unplatet territory adjacent thereto, all as set forth in more detail in Exhibit "A" hereto attached and made a part hereof. Said territory contains a resident population of more than one hundred and less than three thousand people, to-wit: one hundred thirty-four (134). The quantity of land embraced in the proposed village and shown on a plat thereof, which is submitted together with this petition, amounts to approximately eight thousand five hundred and seventy-six (8,576) acres.

That the proposed name of the village shall be Melicon Lakes.
