TO INCORPORATE

We, the undersigned legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, do hereby respectfully petition the County Board of the County of Crow Wing, Minnesota, to call an election for the purpose of determining the proposed incorporation of the Village of Manhattan Beach pursuant to the provision of Chapter 8, Minnesota Statutes of 1927.

The territory proposed to be incorporated consists of the south half of Section 31, the south half of Section 32 and the south half of the northwest quarter of section 33, the west half of the southwest quarter of section 33, the west half of the northwest quarter of section 35, the north half of section 37, section 38, section 39, section 30, section 31, and section 32, all in the Township of Allen, County of Crow Wing, Minnesota. Said territory consists of certain property which has been platted into blocks and lots, which plat has been duly and legally certified according to the Laws of Minnesota and filed at the office of the Register of Deeds in said county, and is designated as follows, to-wit: "Block 1 and 2 Manhattan Beach Entrance Addition" and it includes unplatte territory adjacent thereto, all as set forth in more detail in Exhibit "A" hereto attached and made a part hereof. Said territory contains a resident population of more than one hundred and less than three thousand people, to-wit:

That the proposed name of the village shall be "Manhattan Beach."




