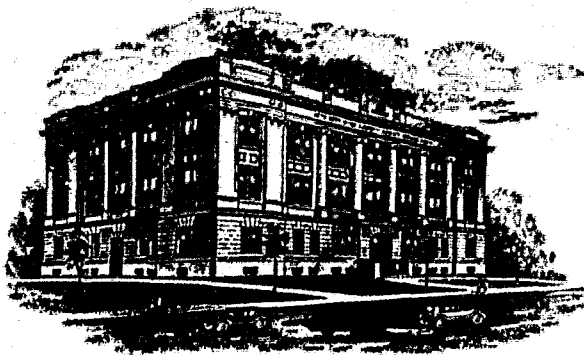

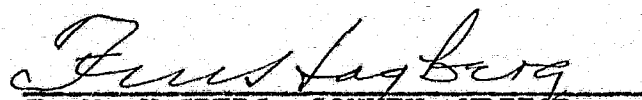

INCORPORATE

THE VILLAGE OF

MANHATTAN BEACH.

We, the undersigned legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, do hereby respectfully petition the County Board of the County of Crow Wing, Minnesota, to call an election for the purpose of determining the proposed incorporation of the Village of Manhattan Beach pursuant to the provision of Chapter 9, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927.

The territory proposed to be incorporated consists of the south half of Section 21, the south half of Section 22 and the south half of the northwest quarter of section 22, the west half of the southwest quarter of section 23, the west half of the northwest quarter of section 25, the north half of section 27, section 28, section 29, section 30, section 31, and section 32, all in the Township of Allen, County of Crow Wing, Minnesota. Said territory consists of certain property which has been platted into blocks and lots, which plat has been duly and legally certified according to the Laws of Minnesota and filed at the office of the Register of Deeds in said county, and is designated as follows, to-wit: "Block 1 and 2 Manhattan Beach Entrance Addition" and it includes unplatted territory adjacent thereto, all as set forth in more detail in Exhibit "A" hereto attached and made a part hereof. Said territory contains a resident population of more than one hundred and less than three thousand people, to-wit:

The quantity of land embraced in the proposed village and shown on a plat thereof, which is submitted together with this petition, amounts to approximately three thousand four hundred and ninety-nine (3,499) acres.

That the proposed name of the village shall be "Manhattan Beach."

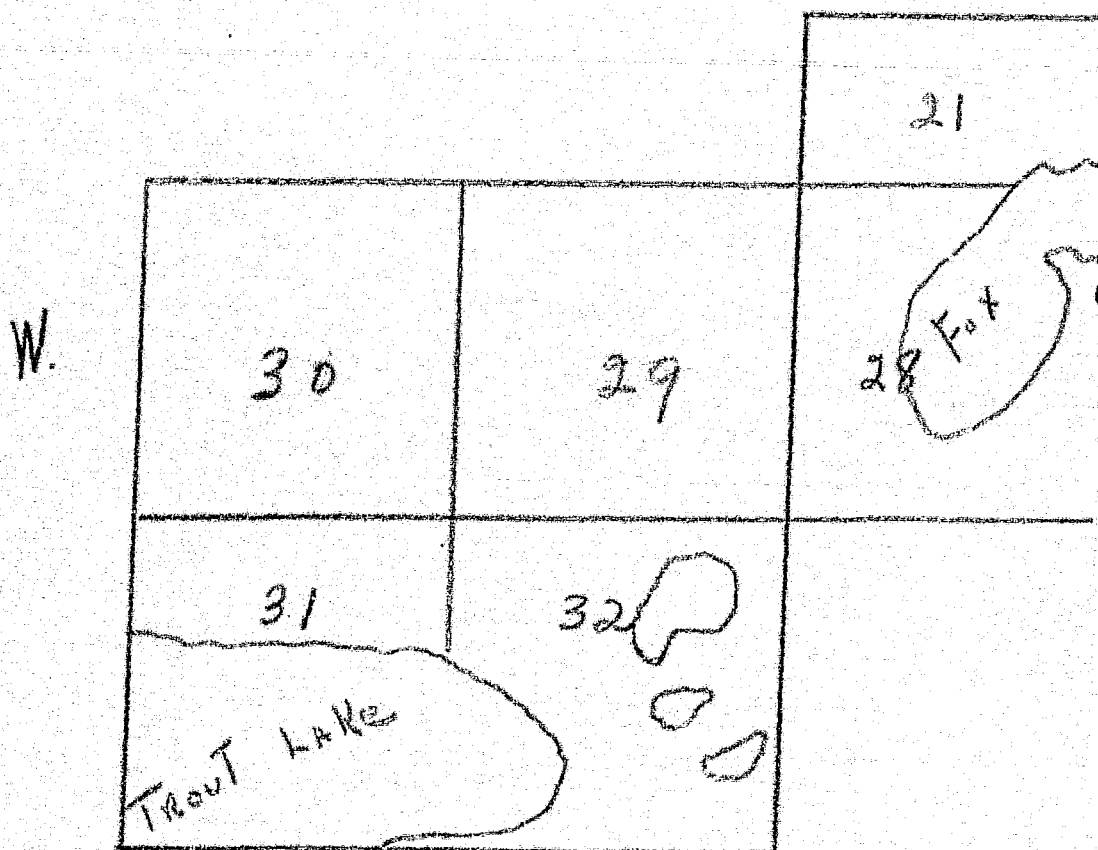

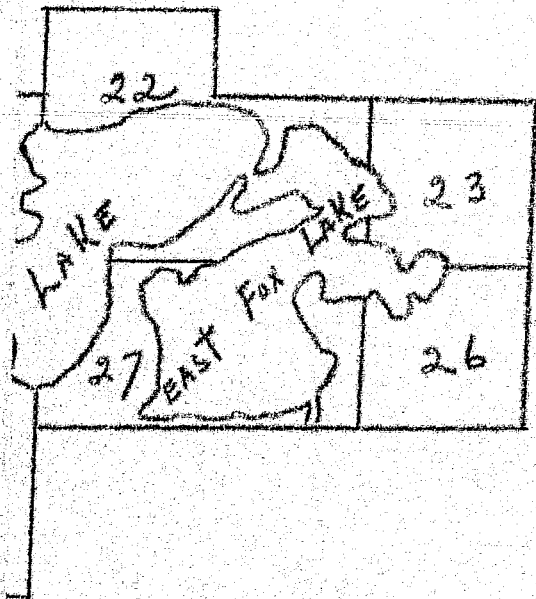
