PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The Board of Managers of the Minnesota Congress of Parents and Teachers have voted the month of October as membership and enrollment month for the State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, At this time the attention of all people is directed to the social and economic problems incident to the maintenance of the American Institutions, the solution of which is contingent upon the proper training of the citizens of tomorrow, and

WHEREAS, The effectiveness of our educational program will depend in a large measure not only upon intelligent, fearless, and public spirited men and women in education but also upon support of our schools by all citizens of the country, and

WHEREAS, The Parent-Teachers Organizations of this nation provide an instrument through which the support of the people may be focused upon the educational program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HAROLD G. OTAVILL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October of this year as the month in which special attention shall be given to mobilizing all citizens of this State to the support of the efforts of the Parent-Teachers Organization to the end that the objectives of education in the maintenance and extension of the privileges and
