PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Minnesota has resolved that October 11th of each year shall be observed as "General Pulaski's Memorial Day", and

WHEREAS, October 11, 1939 marks the One Hundred and Sixtieth anniversary of the death of General Casimir Pulaski, Revolutionary War hero, and

WHEREAS, It is altogether fitting and proper that honorable recognition should be given to the memory of this illustrious son of Poland, who rendered invaluable assistance to our forefathers in their struggle to establish American freedom, and who gave his life on October 11, 1779 as a result of wounds received in that struggle;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HARGIS E. DEANSEN, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

Sunday, October 11, 1939

as
Pulaski Memorial Day

and urge its observance by the people of Minnesota, with appropriate ceremonies, and I also request public officials and people generally to display the flag of the United States on that day.
