

Ordinance No. VIII.

An Ordinance Annexing certain Lots of Land to the Village of Hadley,
Murray county, Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Hadley do ordain as follows:

Section I. That the following described lots or lands, to-wit:
lot one (1) of lot five (5); lots one (1) two (2) three (3) and four
(4) of lot two (2) of lot five (5); and lot two (2) of lot five (5)
of the northeast quarter of section eleven (11) township one hundred
six (106) north of range forty two (42) in Murray county, state of
Minnesota; be and the same are hereby annexed to said village and shall
become a part of said village as effectually as if they had been
originally a part thereof.

Section II. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its
publication, and the filing of certified copies thereof in the offices
of the County Auditor of said county and of the Secretary of state of
Minnesota.
