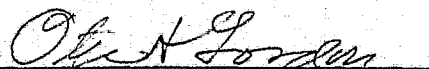

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION TO

INCORPORATE

THE VILLAGE OF

ISLAND VIEW

We, the undersigned legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, do hereby respectfully petition the County Board of the County of Koochiching, Minnesota, to call an election for the purpose of determining the proposed incorporation of the Village of Island View pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 9, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927.

The territory proposed to be incorporated consists of Sections 33, 32, 31, 30, 29, 28, 19 and that part of Section 20 lying southerly of the boundary line of the State of Minnesota and the Province of Ontario, Canada, all in Township 71, N. Range 22, W. 4th P.M., all in the township of Ray, Koochiching County, Minnesota. Said territory consists of certain property which has been platted into blocks and lots, which plats have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of Minnesota and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in said county, and is designated as follows, to-wit: Plat of Island View and Plat of Sha Sha, and they include unplatted territory adjacent thereto, all as set forth in more detail in "Exhibit A" hereto attached and made a part hereof. Said territory contains a resident population of not less than fifty people, to-wit: Fifty-Eight (58). The quantity of land embraced in the proposed village and shown in "Exhibit A", which is submitted together with this petition, amounts to approximately Two thousand two hundred twenty-four and 90/100ths acres (2,224.90 acres).

That the proposed name of the village shall be Island View.

That this Petition is dated this 29th day of August, 1939, and respectfully submitted to the Board of County Commissioners for its approval and for such other action as is required by law.

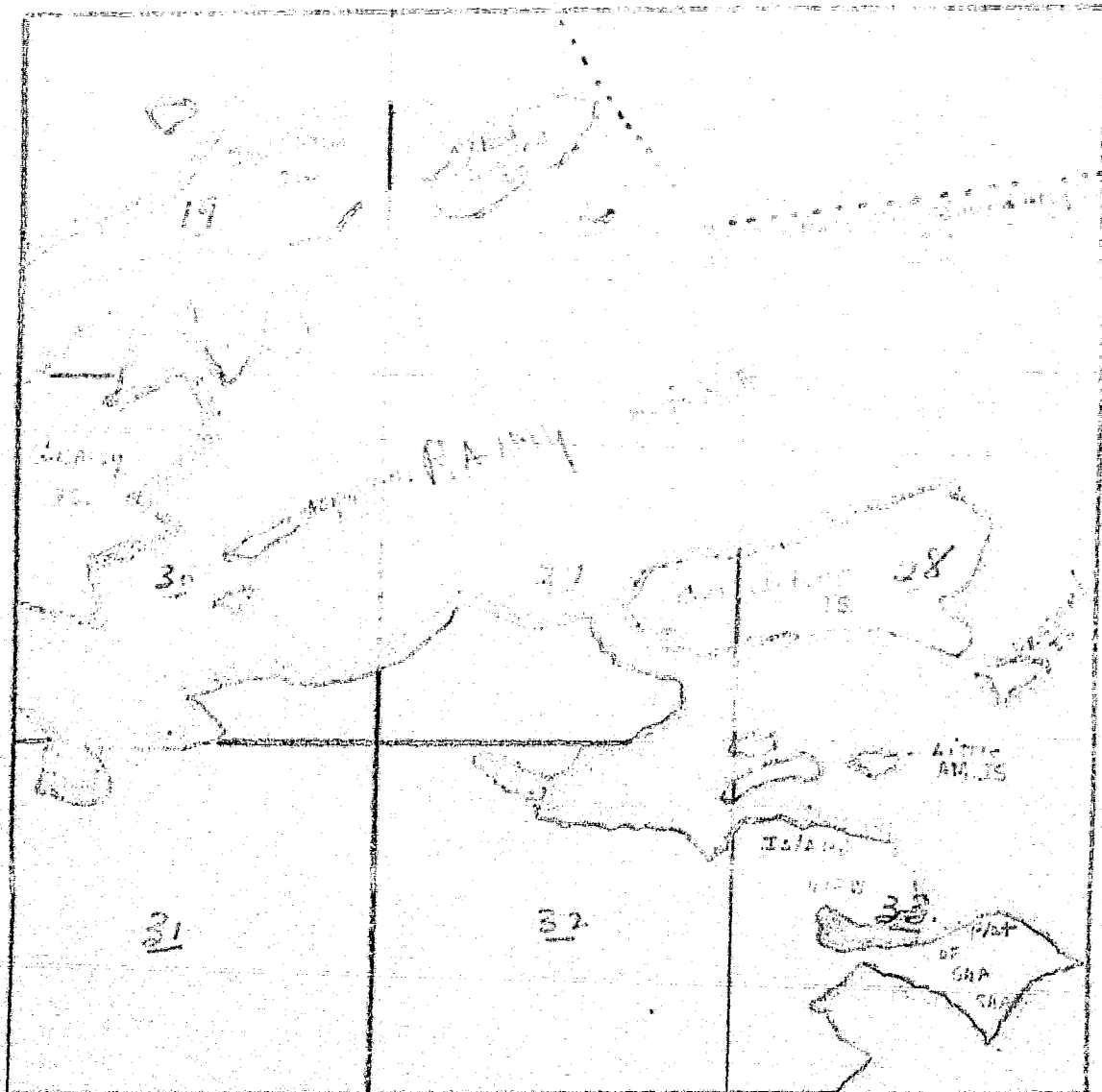
