


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint VICTOR J. MICHAELSON, of St. Paul, Minnesota, to be Special Assistant Attorney General to represent the State of Minnesota in the pending case of United States of America vs. 4450.72 Acres, More or Less, of Land in Clearwater County, State of Minnesota, Ah Nay She Nah Boy, et al., and I hereby fix his compensation at the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day when engaged in the preparation of said case for trial, and at the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day when engaged in the trial thereof, such compensation to be paid from the appropriation made to the Division of Game and Fish of the Department of Conservation. Said appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 28th day of December, 1939.


