FORMS FOR INCORPORATION OF VILLAGES

(1) Petition for Incorporation of Village

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Hennepin, Minnesota:

The undersigned 36 voters, residents of the territory hereinafter described hereby petition your honorable board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote on the proposition of incorporating such territory as a village under the Revised Laws of 1905, as amended, to be known by the name of Loretto. The territory proposed to be incorporated is described as follows:

Commencing 80 Rods E. of SW corner of Section 6, Township 118, Range 23 W., thence North 160 Rods, thence East 160 Rods, thence South 160 Rods, Thence West 160 Rods, to point of beginning.

Such territory consists of lands which have been partly (wholly, partly) platted into lots and blocks, which plat has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this state and has been filed in the office of the register of deeds of Hennepin County, the county in which said lands lie, (and the unplatted part of such territory adjoins the platted portion and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government). Such territory contains 160 acres of land and has 120 actual residents thereon, as has been duly ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the 7th day of Feb. 1940 as appears by the verification hereto.

WHEREAS the petition to incorporate the Village of Lorotte was this day duly delivered to the Board of County Commissioners, and the same is hereby approved; now, therefore, be it resolved that the 18th day of March, 1940, between the hours of 9 A. M. and 5 P. M. be and is hereby fixed as the time, and that certain building known as the Goffling Building located on Lots 8 and 9, Block 5, Lorotte, Railway Street, within the territory described in said petition as the place where an election shall be held to determine whether or not the territory described in said petition shall be incorporated as the Village of Lorotte; be it further resolved that John Egan, A. VanBauson and T. A. Dickow be and are hereby appointed inspectors who shall preside and act as judges of said election. Be it further resolved that John Egan be and is hereby designated and appointed to post in three of the most public places in said territory a copy of said petition with notice attached, stating the time and place when and where the electors thereof will vote for or against such incorporation.

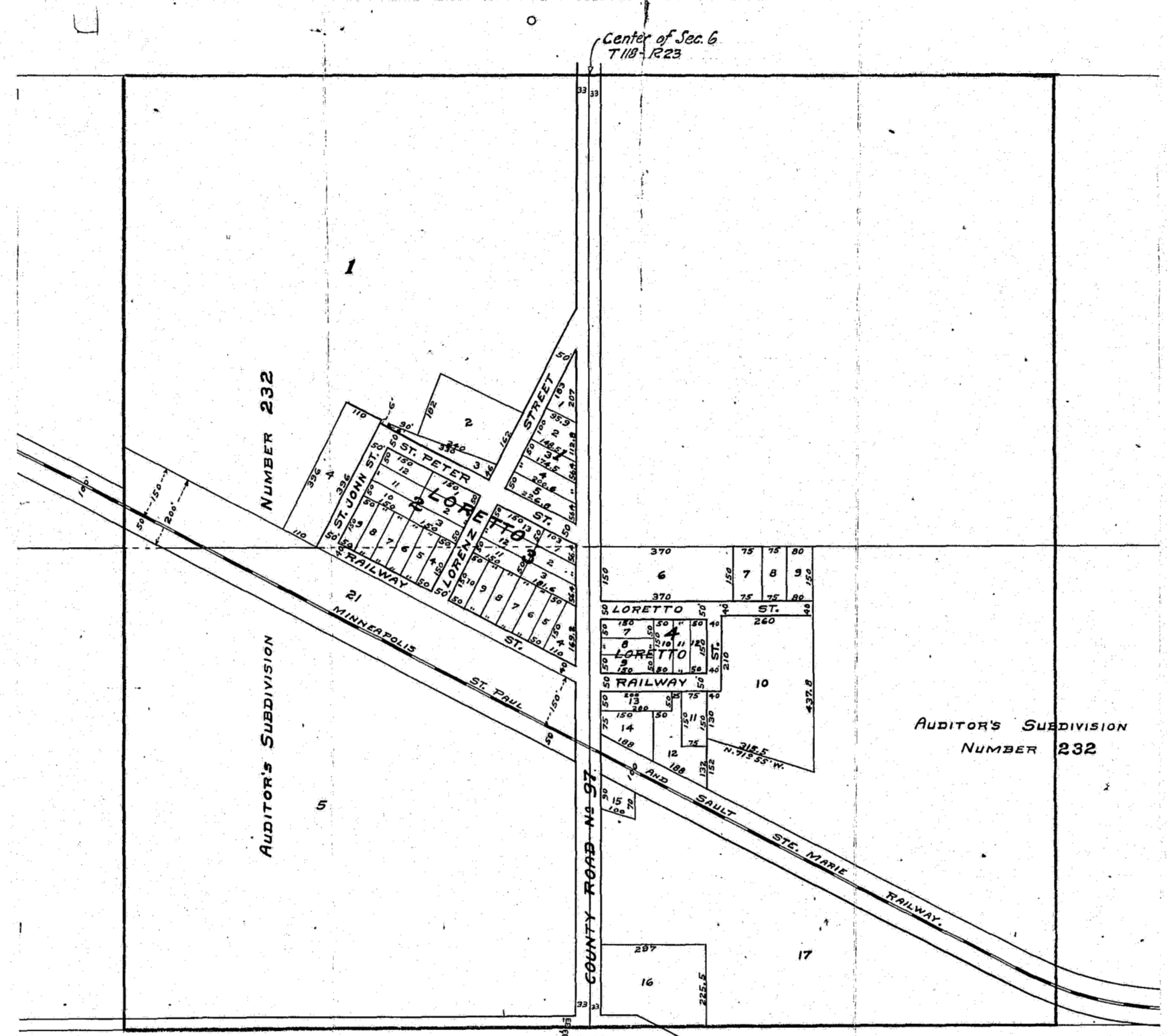
