WHEREAS those over forty are finding it increasingly difficult to obtain steady employment and this group includes heads of families, property owners, World War veterans, and large numbers of loyal citizens who have contributed greatly to the development of this State and,

WHEREAS, by virtue of their experience they have much to offer employers in competence and judgment and,

WHEREAS, it is my desire to aid in alleviating this deplorable condition, let all of us bring the unemployment problem more forcibly to the attention of all employers.


