P E T I T I O N.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,
Kandiyohi County,
Minnesota.

For the purpose of organizing and incorporating a village in accordance with Section 1111 of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, and other laws of the State of Minnesota, pertinent thereto the undersigned respectfully request and petition that you call an election for the determination of such proposed incorporation by such laws.

Further in accordance with said laws, and as a part of this petition, the undersigned do state and make known the following facts, to-wit:

1. The name of the proposed village shall be "Village of Regal"

2. That each of the undersigned is an actual resident and legal voter of and in the territory included in the boundaries of said proposed village.

3. That the territory included in the proposed village is situated in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:

The platted area known as Linton (Regal) Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, in accordance with the plat thereof, on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of said county.

That part of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$; Beginning at S. E. Corner of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ thence West 199.5 ft, thence North 225 ft, thence West 350 ft to East line of Regal, thence North to North-East corner of Regal, thence West 216 ft, thence North to North line of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$, thence East to N. E. Corner of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$, thence South to point of beginning, Sec. 5, T.122 Range 33, containing approximately 12.56 acres.

A Resolution pertaining to the incorporation of the Village of Regal, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota was introduced by Commr. James E. Lindahl, who moved its adoption. Commissioner, Joe Berg, seconded the motion and upon being put to a vote, it was carried by the affirmative vote of Four of the Commissioners and was then thereupon declared adopted.

The following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, as follows, to-wit:

THAT WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to this Board requesting that in accordance with Section 1111 of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1937 and the Laws of Minnesota pertinent thereto, an election be called to determine whether there be incorporated a village to be known as "Village of Regal" and embracing in its territory approximately the following premises (reference is hereby made to said petition for further particularity) to-wit:

The platted area known as Linton (Regal) Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, in accordance with the plat thereof, on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of said County.

That part of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$, Beginning at S. E. Corner of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ thence West 199.5 ft, thence North 325 ft, thence West 350 ft to East line of Regal, thence North to North-East corner of Regal, thence West 316 ft, thence North to North line of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$, thence East to N. E. Corner of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$, thence South to point of beginning, Sec. 5, T. 122, Range 33, containing 13.56 acres

E. $\frac{1}{4}$ eighty ft East from the East line of Regal, thence East 270 ft; thence North 325 ft, thence West 350 ft, thence South 35 ft, thence East 80 ft, thence South 190 ft to point of beginning, Section 5, Township 122, Range 33.

D., 1940, from nine o'clock A. M. until five o'clock P. M. and that the Chairman and County Auditor, on behalf of this Board, give notice of such election and cause the same to be posted according to law, (there being no newspaper within the territory of said proposed village), and the Auditor prepare and furnish the necessary ballots and supplies to be used thereat and that he perform all acts and duties required of him by the laws pertaining to the incorporation of villages.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT O. D. Smith, R. S. Widmer and Henry Brauchler Sr., who are duly qualified electors residing within the said territory are hereby appointed "Inspectors" to conduct the said election and to perform all duties provided by law to be performed by such officers.
