

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927 and upon written request as in said section provided, do hereby constitute and appoint LEWIS L. ANDERSON, of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Attorney for the Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers and Land Surveyors of the State of Minnesota, and direct that his compensation shall be paid from and out of the funds of said Board at the following rates: (a) one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per annum for attending meetings of and advising said Board; (b) for each day necessarily spent in the trial of cases in court a sum not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00); (c) for each day necessarily spent in investigations or in preparation for trial a sum not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).


Said appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.


