as

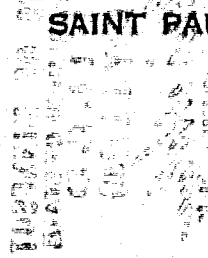
NATIONAL NEW CITIZENS DAY
