

ORDER

Pursuant to petitions filed and notice duly and regularly given the matter of detaching the following described land from the village of Fertile in the County of Polk, State of Minnesota and annexing the same to the Township of Garfield in said County and State namely, Public Park in the Village of Fertile, came duly and regularly on for hearing before the County Board of Polk County and said County Board having found that a majority of the legal voters of both such village and such township have signed said petitions and that the facts and conditions set forth in Section 1129 of Mason's Minnesota Statutes for 1927 same being Section 1 of Chapter 31 of the laws of Minnesota for 1911, as to said lands and the situation and condition thereof, are true, and that it is for the best interests of said village and said township and the owner of the land in question that the same should be detached from such village and annexed to such township, and no objection thereto having been made.

It is hereby ordered by said County Board that said land to-wit: Public Park in the Village of Fertile be and it is hereby detached from said Village of Fertile and annexed to said Township of Garfield.

This order shall be filed in the office of the County Auditor of said County and a duplicate filed in the office of the village recorder of said village of Fertile, and in the office of the town clerk of said Township of Garfield and in the office of the Register of Deeds and in the office of the Secretary of State, within 5 days after the making of this order
