## THE SECTION S. LANSING.

a corporation (hereinafter called the Company), and the STATE OF MINIESOTA (hereinafter called the State), WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on October 16, 1933, pursuant to sub. 3 of Section 2553, Meson's Minnesota Statutes 1987, the Company made, executed and delivered to the State of Minnesota . bond in the penal sum of Twenty-five thousand dollars (025,000.00), conditioned for the faithful performance by N.W. Elsberg of his duties as Commissioner of Highways of the State of Minnesota, and thereby agreed to indemnify the State against any loss or damage sustained by reason of any wrongful act or omission of said N.W. Elsberg as Commissioner of Highways during his continuance in such position, and that he would faithfully and impartially in all things, during his continuance in office, perform the duties thereof. without fraud, deceit or oppression, and pay over without delay to the officer entitled by law thereto, all moneys which should come into his hands by virtue thereof, which bond became effective on October 16, 1933, and ever since has been in full force; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 1940, in the District Court of Ramsey County, Minnesota, in an action wherein M. G. Gullixson, J.W. O'Connell and William Thomas were named as plaintiffs, and N.W. Elsberg and others were named as defendants, and the State of Minnesota was named as intervener. It was adjudged that the State recover from said defendants, and each of them, the sum of One Hundred Thirty-three Thousand One Hundred Forty-two and 61/100ths Dollars (\$133,142.61); and

WHEREAS, said judgment was recovered against said N.W. Elsberg because of his failure to faithfully perform the duties of his office and by reason of wrongful acts and

ORESTERN COLUMN PROPERTIES OF THE STREET and thereby held Company browns lieble to the P extent of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), which is the total liability of said Company because of the loss and damage which resulted to the State as the result of the wrongful acts and omissions of said N.W. Elsbergs

- 1. Said Company has paid to the State because of its liability under the bond aforesaid, by reason of the facts aforesaid, the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), and the State has accepted and hereby accepts such payment as a discharge of the liability of said Company to the State arising from the wrongful acts and omissions of said N.W. Elsberg as Commissioner of Highways, and in full satisfaction, payment and release of the bond aforesaid, being bond number 7200824 of the Company.
- 2. The State does not by this release, release said N.W. Elsberg from any part of his full liability under the judgment aforesaid, except only to the extent of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00).

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, said Company has caused this agreement to be executed by its be flesielent thereunto duly authorized, and the State has caused it to be executed by its Commissioner of Highways and its Attorney General. Dated May 28/1, 1940.
