PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the United States Flag, which is designated under Federal law and headed by the President of the United States as Secretary Resident General, has designated the period of June 14 - 16th as UAS Day, the purpose of which is to promote national unity that will make this great country of ours secure and inviolable in a world fraught with intolerance, greed and violence, and,

WHEREAS, during UAS Day it is planned to conduct throughout all the land exercises and ceremonies whereby the American people will reaffirm their faith in the institutions symbolized by the American Flag, among which are Freedom of Speech, Freedom of the Press, Freedom of Religion, Personal Liberty and other blessings of life unknown today to the people of many other countries,

AND WHEREAS, I, WALTER G. STANLEY, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby (1) instruct the State Superintendent of Public Instruction to arrange through patriotic exercises and otherwise for the appropriate observance of UAS Day in all the public schools; and (2) direct the State officials concerned to display the United States Flag on all State buildings as well as on all State vehicles; and (3) I do invite the people of the State of Minnesota to fly the stars and stripes at their homes and other suitable places and on their cars, and in every community to hold special
