PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, since 1910 when Fathers' Day was founded, an increasing support has been given to the national observance of one Sunday in each year for special tribute to American fathers, and,

WHEREAS, it is well that this typically American celebration be perpetuated, and,

WHEREAS, the sons and daughters of Minnesota as well as the other states of the union are in accord with an observance that places their fathers in a position of honor beside their mothers,

NOW THEREFORE, I, HAROLD E. STASSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 16, 1949 as Fathers' Day in the State of Minnesota and urge that we citizens of Minnesota on this day make a special effort to honor our fathers.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this 6th day of June, 1949.
