PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,  
COUNTY OF ITASCA, STATE OF MINNESOTA:

The undersigned electors, residents upon the following described lands which have been partly platted into lots and blocks, and upon lands adjacent thereto, in the County of Itasca in the State of Minnesota and not in any incorporated village, which said plat has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this state and filed in the office of the register of deeds for the county in which said lands, or a major portion thereof, lie, to-wit:

Sections Twenty-two (22), Twenty-three (23), Twenty-six (26) and Twenty-seven (27) in Township Sixty-two (62) of Range Twenty-six (26), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian,
