PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the National Safety Council is conducting a nation-wide campaign to cut down the heavy annual July accident toll, which last year took 8,800 lives in this country and,

WHEREAS, this July toll is due largely to the Independence Day holiday and increased summer traffic and recreational activities, and,

WHEREAS, the citizens of Minnesota are eager to help save human lives,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HAROLD E. STASSON, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, call upon every man, woman and child throughout the state to cooperate with the National Safety Council for greater safety during this summer and particularly during the month of July.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul, this twenty-first day of June, 1940.
