That pursuant to the provisions of the Soil Conservation Districts Law, Chapter 441, Minnesota Session Laws 1937, a petition for the creation of the East Goodhue Soil Conservation District was filed with the State Soil Conservation Committee; that the proceedings specified in the said act were taken pursuant to the said petition as more fully appears in the statement by the State Soil Conservation Committee hereto attached and made a part of this application; that this application is being filed in order to complete the organization of the said district as a governmental subdivision and a public body, corporate and politic, as provided by the said act; and that the State Soil Conservation Committee has appointed the undersigned as supervisors of the said Soil Conservation District.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

Be it known that on the eleventh day of March, 1940, a petition for the organization of the East Goodhue Soil Conservation District, signed by more than 25 land occupiers, was duly filed in the Office of the State Soil Conservation Committee:

That on the twenty-ninth day of March, 1940, at Frontenac; on the twenty-ninth day of March, 1940, at Red Wing; on the thirtieth day of March, 1940, at Goodhue, public hearing was held after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

That on the first day of May, 1940, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory and did define the boundaries thereof;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of the creation of the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the said defined boundaries on the fifth day of August, 1940;

That the result of the said referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the said referendum were in favor of the erection of the said district;

That thereafter on the fourth day of September, 1940, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that the operation of the said district is administratively practicable and feasible;

That the boundaries of the said district were defined by the State Soil Conservation Committee as follows:

Including the Townships of Hay Creek, Featherstone, Burnside, Florence, Central Point, Wacouta, Red Wing, Belvidere and Goodhue in the County of Goodhue, State of Minnesota.

There shall be exempted from the lands bounded by the above description all parts or parcels of lands used for burial, religious or school purposes; all tracts of lands in cities, villages or towns, which lands are used exclusively for habitation or business purposes other than farming; and in rural or urban areas any tracts of three acres or less which are used principally for habitation or business purposes other than farming.

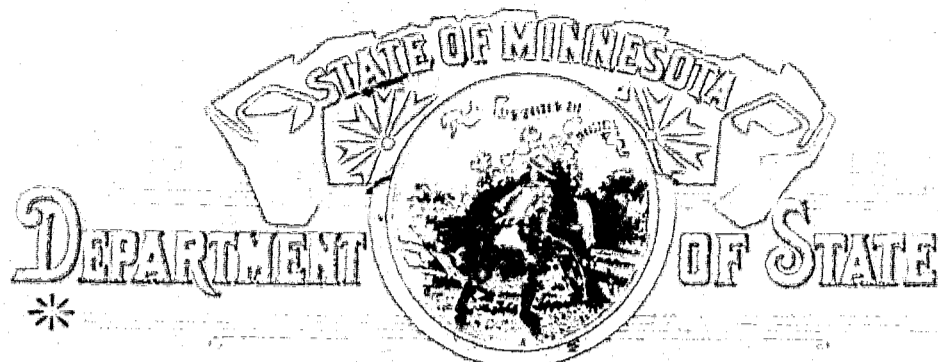

**CERTIFICATE OF DUE ORGANIZATION OF THE EAST GOODHUE
SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT.**

To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, ARNOLD USEBURN, of LAKE CITY, MINNESOTA, and
B. S. ERESON, of GOODHUE, MINNESOTA, THE DULY APPOINTED
SUPERVISORS OF THE EAST GOODHUE SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT,
ACTING PURSUANT TO THE MINNESOTA SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICTS
LAW, CHAPTER 661 OF THE LAWS OF MINNESOTA FOR 1937, & PROVED
APRIL 26, 1937, HAVE FILED IN THIS OFFICE AN APPLICATION,
SUBSCRIBED AND SWORN TO BY EACH OF THEM BEFORE AN OFFICER
AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO TAKE AND CERTIFY OATHS, SETTING FORTH:

(1) THAT A PETITION FOR THE CREATION OF THE DISTRICT WAS
FILED WITH THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION COMMITTEE, PURSUANT
TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICTS
LAW, AND THE PROCEEDINGS SPECIFIED IN SAID ACT WERE TAKEN
PURSUANT TO SUCH PETITION, THAT THE SAID APPLICATION WAS
FILED IN ORDER TO COMPLETE THE ORGANIZATION OF THE DISTRICT
AS A GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISION AND A PUBLIC BODY, CORPORATE
AND POLITICAL, AND THAT THE STATE COMMITTEE HAS APPOINTED THEM
AS SUPERVISORS;

(2) THE NAME AND OFFICIAL RESIDENCE OF THE DISTRICT SUPERVISORS,
TOGETHER WITH A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE APPOINTMENTS EVIDENCING
THEIR RIGHT TO OFFICE;

(3) THEIR TERM OF OFFICE;

(4) THE NAME WHICH IS PROPOSED FOR THE DISTRICT; AND

(5) THE LOCATION OF THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE SUPERVISORS
OF THE DISTRICT; AND

WHEREAS, A STATEMENT OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMITTEE,
ACCOMPANYING THE ABOVE-MENTIONED APPLICATION HAS BEEN FILED
IN THIS OFFICE, SETTING FORTH THAT A PETITION FOR THE CREATION
OF THE EAST GOODHUE SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT WAS FILED WITH
THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION COMMITTEE; THAT, AFTER DUE NOTICE
A HEARING WAS HELD, AND THE COMMITTEE DULY DETERMINED THAT
THERE IS NEED, IN THE INTEREST OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY,
AND WELFARE, FOR A SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT TO FUNCTION IN
THE PROPOSED TERRITORY, AND THAT THE COMMITTEE DEFINED THE
BOUNDARIES THEREOF; THAT THEN, AFTER DUE NOTICE, A REFERENDUM
WAS HELD ON THE QUESTION OF THE CREATION OF SAID DISTRICT, AND
THE RESULTS OF SAID REFERENDUM SHOWED A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES
CAST TO BE IN FAVOR OF THE CREATION OF SAID DISTRICT; AND
THAT THEREAFTER THE COMMITTEE DID DULY DETERMINE THAT THE
OPERATION OF THE PROPOSED DISTRICT IS ADMINISTRATIVELY PRACTI-
CABLE AND FEASIBLE. SAID STATEMENT ALSO SET FORTH THE
BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT AS DEFINED BY THE STATE COMMITTEE.

Now, THEREFORE, I, MIKE HOLL, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY LAW, DO HEREBY FEND, AFTER EXAMINATION OF THE APPLICATION AND STATEMENT REFERRED TO ABOVE, THAT THE SAME PROPOSED FOR SAID DISTRICT IS NOT IDENTICAL WITH THAT OF ANY OTHER SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT OF THIS STATE OR SO NEARLY SIMILAR AS TO LEAD TO CONFUSION OR UNCERTAINTY; AND

I DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT THE SAID SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT HAS BEEN FULLY ORGANIZED AND CONSTITUTES A GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE AND A PUBLIC BODY, CORPORATE AND POLITICAL, VESTED WITH ALL THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON SUCH DISTRICTS BY LAW.



In TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I HEREBY SET MY HAND AND AFFIX THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, AT THE CAPITAL, IN ST. PAUL, THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD, ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FORTY.
