PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Minnesota has resolved that October 11th of each year shall be observed as "General Pulaski's Memorial Day", and

WHEREAS, October 11, 1840 marks the one-hundred and sixty-first anniversary of the death of General Casimir Pulaski, Revolutionary War hero, and

WHEREAS, it is altogether fitting and proper that honorable recognition should be given to the memory of this illustrious son of Poland, who rendered invaluable assistance to our forefathers in their struggle to establish American freedom, and who gave his life on October 11, 1779 as a result of wounds received in that struggle;

BEFORE ME, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim

Friday, October 11, 1940

as

GENERAL PULASKI'S MEMORIAL DAY

and urge its observance by the people of Minnesota, with appropriate ceremonies, and I also request public officials and people generally to
