PROCLAMATION

BIRMINGHAM, in the year 1492 A. D. Christopher Columbus, an

Italian, sailing under the flag of Spain and proceeding upon the theory
which his voyage proved to be correct, that the world was round, landed
upon the shores of the continent of North America, and,

COLUMBUS, the courage, tenacity and colonizing ability of this
great man laid the corner stone for the settlement and growth of the
Western Hemisphere and particularly North America.

HIS EXCELLENCY, ARTHUR G. SHAW, Governor of the State of
Minnesota, do hereby proclaim and designate

Saturday, October 12, 1940

as

COLUMBUS DAY

and I strongly urge the people of Minnesota to observe this day with ap-
propriate ceremonies and celebrations in order that the qualities of
courage and tenacity with which Christopher Columbus was so richly en-
dowed may be brought forcibly to the attention of the people of this state
and great in their hearts courage and determination to overcome the dif-
ficulties besetting them in these trying times.
