Dear Mr. Strunk:

This will advise you that on behalf of the United States I have signed a lease agreement concerning certain property acquired by the United States in connection with the Pine Island Project, LA-MN-4. Two signed copies of the agreement are attached for your use.

In order to facilitate the giving of any notice or consent, or the doing of any other action on behalf of the United States under the lease agreement, I have authorized the Chief of the Forest Service, United States Department of Agriculture, to act as my representative. The Chief of the Forest Service and designated members of his staff will, therefore, communicate and consult with you and your representatives whenever the execution of the various terms and conditions of the lease agreement makes it appropriate to do so. Similarly, you will probably find it convenient to consult or communicate with the Chief of the Forest Service whenever it becomes necessary or desirable to secure further advice from this Department in connection with the execution of the terms and conditions of the lease agreement.

I am sure that it is your wish, as it is mine, that the cooperation which has resulted in the present agreement continue, and that the fulfillment of the objectives of the agreement constitute a significant contribution to the conservational program in the State of Minnesota as well as to the national conservational program.

STATEMENT OF THE CONTRACT

And

THE STATE OF MINNESOTA,

THE STATE, MINN., DATED AND ONBOARD INTO THE PORT OF MINNEAPOLIS, STATE
OF MINNESOTA, acting by and through the Secretary of Agriculture, pursuant
to Title III of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act (hereinafter referred
to as the United States), and the STATE OF MINNESOTA, acting
by and through the Commissioner of Conservation, pursuant to
Sections 6036-1 and 6036-2, Hagen's Minnesota Statutes, 1927, 1930
Supplement (hereinafter referred to as the State), which latter shall
also be considered a cooperative agreement within the meaning of
Section 6036-2.

WITNESSED:

The parties hereto, for themselves and their respective suc-
cessors and assigns, do hereby mutually covenant and agree as follows:

1. The United States hereby leases to the State and the State
hires from the United States, upon the terms and conditions hereinafter
set forth, all the real property acquired or to be acquired by the
United States in connection with the Pine Island Project, LA-132-4,
together with all improvements which are located thereon (hereinafter
referred to as the property), subject, however, to all easements,
rights-of-way, licenses, leases, and outstanding interests in, upon,
across or through said property which have heretofore been granted
or reserved by the United States or its predecessors in title, but
excepting and reserving unto the United States of America:

(a) All rights of the United States to the oil, gas, coal
and other minerals or mineral ores whatsoever upon, in or
under said property, together with the usual mining rights,
powers and privileges, including the right of access to and
use of such parts of the surface of the premises as may be

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economy for mining and extractive purposes. The State, however, shall have the right to use stone, gravel, and similar substances from said property, provided such materials are used for construction purposes upon or in connection with said property. In the event the United States determines that the exercise of said mining rights would be inconsistent with the purposes referred to in Section 4 below, it agrees not to exercise such rights during the term of this lease without the written consent of the State. In the event the State or the United States determines that the use of stone, gravel, and similar materials by the State for construction purposes would be inconsistent with the purposes referred to in Section 4 below, the State agrees not to exercise such rights during the term of this lease without the written consent of the United States.

(b) The right, but not the duty, to prosecute developmental work on the property until June 30, 1940, and to do any and all things which it deems necessary or desirable in connection therewith. However, any such developments shall be approved by the State before being initiated.

The property already acquired by the United States in connection with said project is described in Exhibit "A", and the property to be acquired by the United States in connection with said project is described in Exhibit "B", such exhibits being attached hereto and expressly made a part hereof. The property described in Exhibit "B", or any part thereof, shall become subject to all the terms and conditions of this lease when title thereto has vested in the United States, but not before such time. The United States shall notify the State in writing when the title to any of the property described in Exhibit "B" has vested in the United States.

2. The term of this lease shall be fifty (50) years, beginning with the 2nd day of August, 1940, and ending

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on the first day of August, 1950, and shall substantially
be renewed for three (3) successive terms of eighteen (18) years each,
unless written notice to the contrary is given by either party to
the other not less than ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of
this instrument, or any renewal thereof, and each renewal shall be
subject to all the terms and conditions of this lease. If the State
does not deliver up possession of said property upon the expiration
or termination of this lease, or any renewal thereof, it shall be
deemed a tenant from month to month.

3. Subject to the provisions of Section 8 of this lease,
the State shall pay to the United States in Washington, D.C., as
rental for the full term of this lease, and any renewal thereof,
the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) payable on or before the sixtieth day
after the execution of this lease on behalf of the United States.

4. The State shall use said property in accordance with the
following purposes and management practices:

(a) FORESTRY:

Forestry practices shall be of such character as
to maintain the forest lands in a productive condition;
the lands shall be managed to produce sustained or
periodic growths of forest products; utilization prac-
tices shall be administered to prevent waste; manage-
ment practices shall be applied so as to secure the best
growth of desirable species; a planting program con-
sistent with the wildlife and recreational purposes of
the project shall be established to provide appropriate
forest cover on existing open land, the planting to be
carried forward as rapidly as funds permit. The State
shall provide adequate forest protection, including a
satisfactory system of truck trails, fire breaks and
other essential protection improvements, and fire

supplementary equipment. Accounts kept in connection, as wood burning, shall be incorporated to make from forest fire control measures and other control measures as are now offered by the State, and an administration in cooperation with the Federal Government under the Clark-McWayne Law.

The sale of timber or any other products in excess of \$250.00 in value shall be advertised and made to the highest bona fide bidder. The right to reject any or all bids shall be reserved by the State.

(b) WILDLIFE:

Wildlife management practices shall be of such character as to maintain the lands in a productive condition from the standpoint of wildlife; the lands shall be managed to effectuate a balanced wildlife population; the forest management practices shall be so planned as to assure reproduction of desirable species; a planting program shall be established to provide appropriate food and cover. In effectuating these purposes, adequate provision shall be made for controlled public hunting and fishing.

The State shall regulate the taking of fur-bearing animals on the property in accordance with State law. It is understood that the State, through the Department of Conservation, shall seek to obtain legislative sanction to a program regulating the taking of fur-bearing animals on the areas affected by this lease, on an individual trapping permit basis, whereunder a fee shall be charged per pelt for each species taken, and whereunder adequate control of breeding stock can be maintained, and whereby trapping on duck-nesting areas may be controlled during the duck-nesting

Deeded.

Within five years of the execution hereof, consideration is to be given to establishing or leasing a portion of the property as a controlled hunting area.

This matter is to be the subject of mutual agreement between the State and the United States.

(c) RECREATION:

The State shall operate, maintain, and administer the existing and subsequently developed recreational facilities for the use and benefit of the general public, any fees to be charged for such use to be non-discriminatory and consistent with the public non-profit character of the area. Any recreational facilities that may be subsequently developed shall be consistent with the other uses of the land.

(d) The State shall maintain the water level in the various flowages at as constant a stage as possible, each flowage to be held as near as practicable to the height for which the dams and dikes were designed. It is understood that in complying with the above provisions the rules and regulations of the Department of Conservation shall govern.

(e) Vacant buildings acquired with the land and not required in the operation of the project and which may be occupied by squatters or may be a source of other hazards are to be removed or demolished. The salvage material or entire buildings may be used or disposed of by the State in effectuating the purposes set forth in the preceding paragraphs of this section. Any of these salvage materials or buildings may be used by the State on lands owned or controlled by it in the

of said lands or any of which the lands included in
said agreement are a part. Any revenue received by
the State from the disposal of salvaged material or
buildings shall be considered as income from the
property to be expended in accordance with Section 3
below.

- (f) The combined uses, purposes and management practices,
including forestry, recreation, and wildlife,
shall be effectuated in accordance with sound technical
practices.
- (g) The provisions set forth in this section may be
modified from time to time by mutual consent of the
United States and the State.

5. The State shall not use or permit, and shall take such
measures as may be necessary to prevent, the use or occupancy of
said property, or any portion thereof, for any purpose which is in-
consistent or incompatible with the purposes set forth in Section 4
above. Nor shall the State, except with the written consent of the
United States, sublease said property or any portion thereof, or
assign any of its rights or obligations under this lease. This
provision shall not be construed to apply to such employees of the
State as are engaged in the administration of said property during
the period they are actually so engaged.

The State shall not, except with the written consent of the
United States, authorize or permit third persons, including em-
ployees of the State engaged in the administration and management
of the project, to erect dwellings on the property, whether such
authorization or permission creates any rights in such third per-
sons or not.

6. The State shall give preference to the full or part-time
employment of qualified persons legally residing on said property

with the consent of the United States, where the operation, maintenance, or administration of said property provides suitable opportunities for such employment. The State shall, however, have the right to deduct any such amount for costs.

7. The State shall enforce such measures as may now be available under the law for insuring the use of tax-forfeited and other State-owned lands within the boundaries of the project area with that of said property, and for preventing any exploitation of outstanding mineral interests that may be inconsistent with the purposes referred to in Section 4 above, and at the earliest possible date the State shall recommend to the Legislature and present to the Legislature the necessity for the passage of such other measures as may be appropriate for this purpose.

8. For the purpose of keeping a record of the income and revenue received by the State from the use of said property and deposited in the various funds created by State law, and of the monies expended by the State for effecting the purposes set forth in Sections 4 and 9 hereof, the Department of Conservation and its legal successors shall maintain an account accessible at all times for inspection by the United States, to be identified as "account with Pine Island Project, LA-NW 4", for which account all such income and revenue shall be credited and all such expenditures made by the State shall be charged.

During the term of this lease, or any renewal thereof, an amount equal to all income and revenue which the State may receive from the use of said property as shown in said account shall be expended by the State from funds authorized under State law for the purposes set forth in Section 4 above, and for making repairs and replacements on said property as provided in Section 9 below. Any portion of such income and revenue which is not needed for the above purposes as indicated in said account may be expended, provided the State legislature shall have enacted enabling legislation

FORWARDING THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION TO THE STATE OF TEXAS
AND GOVERNOR FOR SUCH PURPOSES AS SHALL BE MUTUALLY AGREED UPON
BY THE STATE AND THE UNITED STATES, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE
STATE OF ADDITIONAL LANDS TO BLOCK IN, ROUND OUT, OR ENLARGE
SAID PROPERTY, OR ADDITIONAL LANDS TO BLOCK IN, ROUND OUT, OR EN-
LARGE OTHER CONSERVATIONAL AREAS ALREADY ESTABLISHED BY AND UNDER
THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE, AND OF LANDS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT
OF NEW CONSERVATIONAL AREAS, FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF ANY SUCH LANDS
ACQUIRED, OR FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF ANY LANDS IN CONSERVATIONAL
AREAS ALREADY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE BY VIRTUE OF
OWNERSHIP OR OTHERWISE, OR TO OTHERWISE FURTHER A GENERAL CON-
SERVATIONAL PROGRAM IN THE STATE AS SHALL BE MUTUALLY AGREED UPON
BY THE STATE AND THE UNITED STATES AT A CONFERENCE HEREINAFTER
PROVIDED FOR. IF THE STATE LEGISLATURE DOES NOT ENACT SUCH EN-
ABLING LEGISLATION, OR IF THE PARTIES HERETO FAIL TO REACH A
MUTUAL AGREEMENT, ANY CREDIT BALANCE FROM INCOME OR REVENUE AS
INDICATED IN SAID ACCOUNT WHICH REMAINS AT THE END OF ANY YEAR IN
WHICH THIS LEASE, OR ANY RENEWAL THEREOF, IS IN FORCE, SHALL, AFTER
THE STATE HAS DEDUCTED THEREFROM A SUM EQUAL TO ANY EXPENDITURES IT
HAS MADE FOR THE OPERATION OF THE PROPERTY IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNT
OF INCOME AND REVENUE RECEIVED DURING THE PRECEDING YEARS COVERED
BY THIS LEASE, BE PAID TO THE UNITED STATES AS A RENTAL FOR THE USE
AND OCCUPATION OF THE PROPERTY BY THE STATE. FAILURE TO MAKE THE
EXPENDITURES OR THE RENTAL PAYMENTS HERIN PROVIDED SHALL NOT
CREATE ANY INDEBTEDNESS ON THE PART OF THE STATE, BUT SHALL ENTITLE
THE UNITED STATES TO TERMINATE THIS LEASE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
PROVISIONS OF SECTION 14 BELOW.

IF THE STATE DOES ENACT SUCH ENABLING LEGISLATION, EITHER
THE STATE OR THE UNITED STATES, AT ANY TIME EITHER OF THEM DE-
TERMINES FROM THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE REPORTS REFERRED

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To the end of this, or otherwise, that the total sum of \$50,000 revenue received by the State from the use and/or sale of said property during all preceding years covered by this lease exceeds or will probably exceed during the current year the total cost to the State of operating the property, may request a conference to determine (a) the rental to be paid during the remainder of the term of this lease, or any renewal thereof; (b) the sums which shall be paid by the State, out of the net revenue derived from the property, to counties or other local governmental subdivisions of the State; (No such payments shall be made, however, unless the State shall pass enabling legislation permitting such payments upon terms satisfactory to the United States.) and (c) the sums to be spent for other conservational purposes. This determination shall be made by mutual agreement, and shall not preclude either the United States or the State from requesting subsequent redeterminations if the amount of net revenue from the operation of the property should materially change.

Not later than the 31st day of July of each year during which this lease is in effect, the State shall furnish the United States with an annual report, in such detail as may be prescribed by the Secretary of Agriculture, showing all income and revenue received from the use of said property, and the disposition made thereof.

"Income and revenue" as referred to herein shall mean receipts from the sale of forest products, hay stumping, hunting and trapping fees, crop and occupancy permits, the operation of recreational facilities, and other receipts of similar character that are derived directly from the lands described in Exhibits "A" and "B" hereof.

9. The State shall assume and defray all costs, charges,

operation, and obligations incident to the use of and duty for the purpose provided herein, and shall maintain property (including equipment left on the property as provided by Section 17 below), subject to other provisions hereof, in good condition and repair, making all repairs and replacements necessitated by deterioration, damage, use, negligence, or any other cause whatsoever, provided, however, that the State shall be obligated to make repairs and replacements caused by defects in the original design, material or construction, or caused by the violent forces of nature only to the extent of such income and revenue received from the use of the property as is available through legislative action. The State shall not remove any improvements, except in accordance with the provisions of Section 4 (e) and 18 hereof, or alter any major improvements, without the written consent of the United States.

It is provided that all obligations assumed under this section are special and limited obligations, payable only as provided in Section 8 above, and from the proceeds of any insurance which the State may secure to indemnify itself against damage or loss of the property, and any additional funds which may be appropriated for such purpose.

10. In any publication, except press notices of momentary and local interest, covering the results of the program referred to in Section 4 above, the State shall recognize that such program was conducted on land acquired and developed in connection with the land conservation and land utilization program of the United States Department of Agriculture.

11. The State shall make provision for sanitation and water purification, and shall enforce such other measures for the protection of the public health on the property as shall meet with the requirements of the Minnesota Board of Health.

12. The State shall save the United States harmless from

any 2000, or more, 1900-1907, or otherwise calculation of the period relating; and of any amount or compensation owing liability to any person or property, and also directly or indirectly to the use or occupancy of said property.

13. The State shall submit not later than one year after the date of this lease, and annually thereafter, a general plan of operation and development setting forth the measures to be taken by the State during the ensuing year to effectuate the purposes of this lease. The State shall furnish the United States with such information in regard to its use and management of said property as may be requested from time to time. The State shall also permit at all times any duly authorized representative or representatives of the United States to enter upon and inspect said property.

14. This lease may be terminated by the United States if all or any part of the land covered thereby is needed by the United States for military or other use of a kind not provided for herein, but such termination shall not be made without the consent of the State, unless the United States has funds available which may be used to reimburse and does reimburse the State for such of the expenditures it has incurred, over and above the income and revenue derived from the project, for the purpose of developing, protecting, and administering the land involved, as are mutually agreed to have been reasonably necessary for this purpose.

In the event the State shall fail, neglect, or refuse to fulfill or perform any of the terms and conditions of this lease, the United States shall have the right to terminate this lease, or any renewal thereof, by giving notice addressed to the State that the term of this lease shall cease and determine twenty-four (24) months subsequent to the date of such notice, unless,

either Company, such branch or default to be recorded. On the expiration of the County-Power (7) month specified in said notice, and failure of the State to have recorded such branch or default, and to still remain and continue. However, before any notice of termination is given, a meeting shall be promoted for discussions between officials of the State and the United States to be held at such time and place as shall be mutually agreed upon by the State and the United States.

15. Upon the expiration or termination of this lease, or any renewal thereof, the State shall quietly and peacefully remove from said property and surrender possession thereof, and the United States may immediately, or at any time thereafter, reenter and take possession of the property and remove all persons therefrom. The term "reenter" shall not be restricted to its technical legal meaning. The United States may also take any action in law or in equity which it may deem necessary to regain possession of the property or to assure the fulfillment of the purposes of this lease.

16. Upon the expiration or termination of this lease, or any renewal thereof, the State shall have the right to remove only those improvements to be selected by the State which have been created by it and of which the appraised value shall bear that proportion to the appraised value of other improvements not to be removed as the funds expended by the State in said improvements in excess of the amount spent out of the income and revenue account referred to in Section 8 hereof bear to the amount spent on improvements from said income and revenue account; provided, however, that unless such improvements are removed by the State within eighteen (18) months from the date this lease, or any renewal thereof, expires or is terminated, title to such improvements

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shall automatically vest in the United States, and provided further
that the United States shall have the option to purchase such im-
provements upon the expiration or termination of this lease, or
any renewal thereof, or within six (6) months thereafter. In the
event this option is exercised, the purchase price shall be the
fair value of the improvements as of the time of the expiration or
termination of this lease.

17. Those items of equipment which the United States leaves
on the property after completing its developmental program, as
provided in Section 1(b) above, shall be available to the State
for use in administration of the property in accordance with the
terms of this lease. (Such items of equipment shall be listed in
Exhibit "G", which shall be attached hereto and made a part of this
lease at the time the United States completes its developmental pro-
gram as provided in Section 1 (b) above.) When such equipment,
through normal usage or through accidental breakage, shall have
become unserviceable, the State shall render an accurate statement
of the facts to the United States, which shall then provide for
its disposition. Attached to the annual report rendered to the
United States, in accordance with Section 9 above, shall be an
inventory of the equipment and a statement of its condition.

18. The United States shall have the right, but shall be
under no duty, to prosecute or defend, in the name of the United
States of America or in the name of the State, any action or pro-
ceedings appropriate or necessary for the protection of the title
to, possession of, or any other interest in said property.

19. The invalidity of any provision of this lease, or of
any part thereof, shall not affect the validity of the remaining
provisions or the rights and obligations of the parties thereunder.

20. The failure of the United States to insist upon the

strict construction of any of the terms, covenants, agreements, and conditions herein contained shall not constitute a waiver or relinquishment of the right of the United States to enforce thereafter such terms, covenants, agreements, and conditions, but the same shall continue in full force and effect.

21. Any notice, consent, or other action to be given or done by the United States under this lease, or any renewal thereof, shall be valid only if in writing and executed or performed by the Secretary of Agriculture or his duly authorized representative, or in the case of a successor to the rights of the Department of Agriculture hereunder, by the chief administrative officer of such successor or his duly authorized representative. All notices to be given under this lease, or any renewal thereof, shall be delivered or forwarded by mail, addressed, in the case of the State to the Commissioner of Conservation, or State official succeeding to his duties, St. Paul, Minnesota, and in the case of the United States, to the United States Department of Agriculture, or to its successor hereunder, Washington, D.C.

22. No member of or delegate to Congress or resident commissioner shall be admitted to any share or part of this lease, or any renewal thereof, or to any benefit to arise therefrom.

23. This lease shall become effective when duly executed by all the persons indicated below:
