P R O C L A M A T I O N

W H E R E A S , The United States Department of Justice, by and through its Immigration and Naturalization Service, is conducting an Alien Registration program throughout the nation, and

W H E R E A S , many aliens subject to the registration law have failed to register either because of negligence or a misunderstanding of the law which makes December 26, 1940, the deadline for registration, and

W H E R E A S , under the terms of the law and the regulations

Registration takes place at all first and second class post offices and all post offices located at county seats.

All aliens 14 years of age and over must register in person and be fingerprinted.

Alien children under 14 must be registered by their parents or guardians, but need not be fingerprinted.

Sample registration forms may be procured in advance at any post office.

There are no fees of any kind connected with registration. Postmasters and the Alien Registration Division of the Department of Justice stand ready to assist aliens in every way possible.

Failure to comply with the Alien Registration Act of 1940 may result in a \$1,000 fine, six months imprisonment or both,

W H E N S A E , The post offices will soon be extremely busy with the annual Christmas rush, a great deal of confusion and hardship can be anticipated if those aliens who have not already registered will do so at once.

N O W T A S S E M B L E , I, Harold E. Hansen, Governor of Minnesota, call upon all aliens in this state who have not registered at this time to do so at the earliest opportunity and before December 16, 1940.

I N W I T N E S S W H E R E O F , I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital in St. Paul this 30th day of November, 1940.
