PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Justice, by and through its Immigration and Naturalization Service, is conducting an Alien Registration program throughout the nation, and

WHEREAS, many aliens subject to the registration law have failed to register either because of negligence or a misunderstanding of the law which makes December 26, 1940, the deadline for registration, and

Registration takes place at all first and second class post offices and all post offices located at county seats.

All aliens 14 years of age and over must register in person and be fingerprinted.

Alien children under 14 must be registered by their parents or guardians, but neet not be fingerprinted.

Sample registration forms may be procured in advance at any post office.

There are no fees of any kind connected with registration. Postmasters and the Alien Registration Division of the Department of Justice stand ready to assist aliens in every way possible.

Failure to comply with the Alien Registration Act of 1940 may result in a \$1,000 fine, six months imprisonment or both,
