PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF A VILLAGE

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, ITASEA COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

The undersigned electors, residents upon the following described lands which have been partly platted into lots and blocks and upon lands adjacent thereto, in the County of Itasea in the State of Minnesota, and not in any incorporated village, which said plat has been duly certified according to the Laws of the State of Minnesota, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County in which said lands or a larger portion thereof lie, to-wit:

The East One-Half of the Southeast Quarter ( $E\frac{1}{2}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eighteen (18); the Southwest Quarter of Section Seventeen (17); The East Half of the Northwest Quarter ( $E\frac{1}{2}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ); the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ); Lots Three (3), Four (4), Five (5) and Six (6), all in Section Twenty (20), and Lot Two (2) in Section Nineteen (19), all in Township One Hundred Forty-Eight (148), North Range Twenty-Seven (27), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian,

hereby petition your Honorable Board to appoint a time and place, when and where the electors actually residing upon said lands may vote for or against the incorporation of a village to be named "Squaw Lake."

The number of persons actually residing in said territory are 111 as has been duly ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the 14th day of September, 1940, as appears by the verification hereto.

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE FIXING TIME AND PLACE  
FOR ELECTION AND APPOINTING INSPECTORS IN  
CONNECTION WITH INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE OF  
SQUAW LAKE

WHEREAS, a petition has been signed by more than twenty-five electors who are residents upon certain lands proposed to be included in the Village of Squaw Lake, Itasca County, Minnesota, setting out the lands to be embraced within said proposed village, the number of actual residents thereon, the name of the village proposed and petitioning that the Board of County Commissioners appoint a time and place, when and where, the electors residing upon said lands may vote for or against the incorporation of a village to be named "Squaw Lake."

NOW THEREFORE, Be it Resolved that the Board of County Commissioners approve said petition that an election be held within the limits of said proposed village in Kananen's Hall on the 9th of December, 1940, between the hours of 10:00 A. M. and 7:00 P. M., at which the electors actually residing upon said land may vote for or against the incorporation of a village to be named "Squaw Lake" and that a copy of said petition with a notice of election attached thereto, signed officially by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and attested by the County Auditor with seal and reading as follows:
