


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, J. A. A. Burrquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, and at the request of G. Howard Spaeth, Commissioner of Taxation, do hereby constitute and appoint Faner C. Wonderly of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as SPECIAL ATTORNEY, in the Department of Taxation, Division of Oil Inspection, for the period commencing January 6, 1941, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said Faner C. Wonderly as such Special Attorney in the Department of Taxation, Division of Oil Inspection, at the sum of One Hundred Seventy Five and NO/100 Dollars per month, to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of Taxation.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 6th day of January, 1941.


