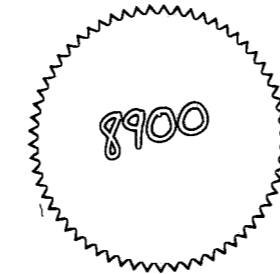

his recognition as such officer, declaring him free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers, and
privileges as are allowed to the Consuls of the most favored Nations in the United States.

of the United States of America, have hereunto subscribed my name and caused the Seal of the
Department of State to be affixed.

DONE at the City of Washington this *second* day of *November*, in the year
of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and *seventy*, and the *19*th year of the
Independence of the United States of America.

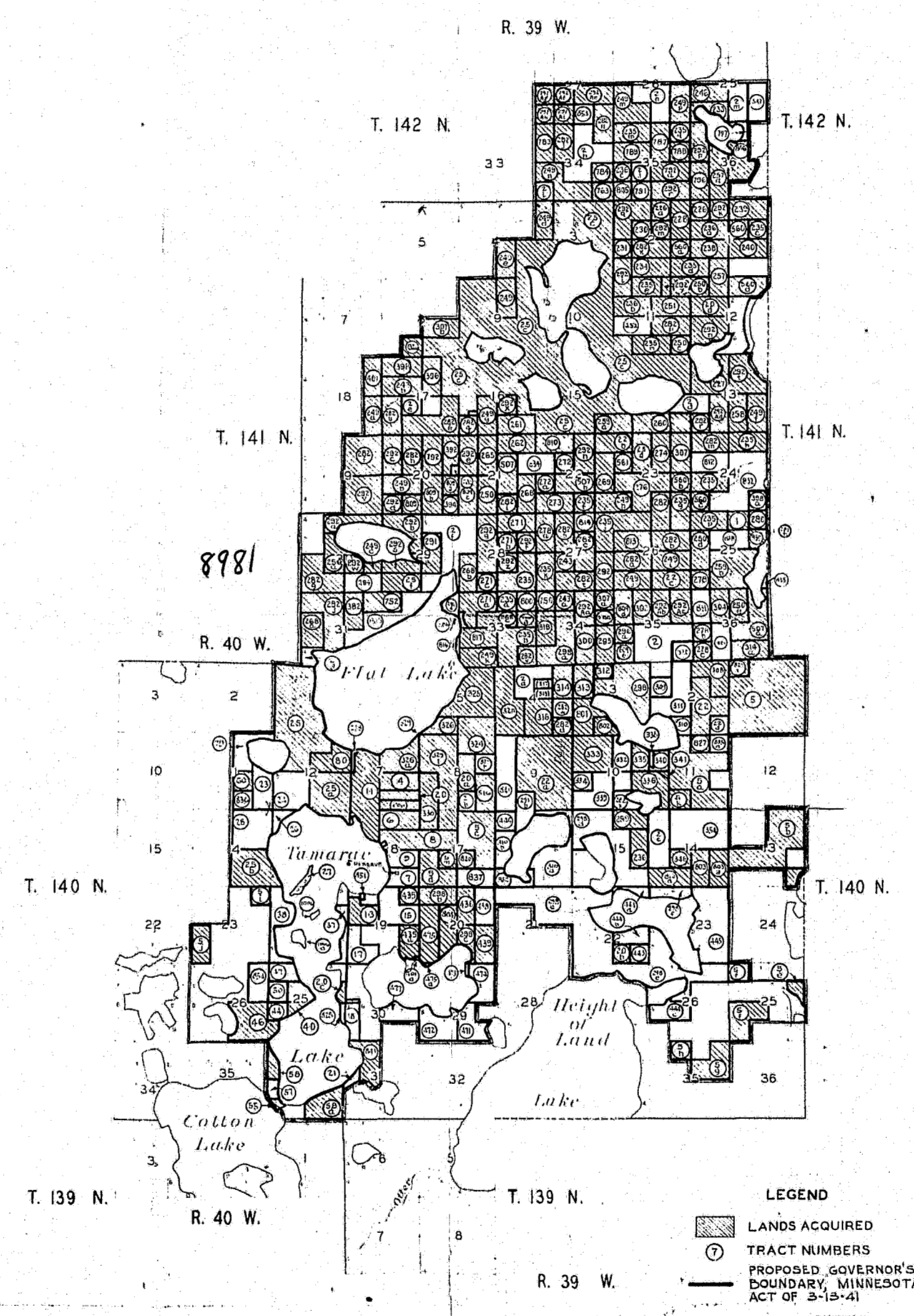

Dear Sir:

In reclosing Consulate of Finland at Duluth.

As you have no doubt read in the public press, the Department of State has ordered all the Finnish Consulates in this country to be closed before the 1st day of August, 1942. The Consul General of Finland at New York will be advised on the 29th of July that, pursuant to his order, this Consulate has been closed.

How long the Finnish Consulates will be closed is problematical. However, until they are reopened the Consuls are not permitted to function as such. I am not sure, but my impression is that the duties that are usually performed by the Consul will be hereafter performed by the Legation of Finland at Washington, D. C.


Until you receive any notice to the contrary, I would suggest that whatever Probate notices that are mailed to you may be forwarded to the Legation of Finland at Washington, D. C.
